To support the need for quality Australian manufactured solid and engineered flooring the ATFA provides manufacturers with the opportunity to become an accredited manufacturer.

What does this mean?

Moisture content, machining tolerances are critical to the performance and floor and grade is important to the appearance of a floor. However it is these aspects that are also difficult for the customer to assess. In effect the ATFA as a third party, someone who is independent to the manufacturer who undertakes to periodically assess these important factors on the consumer's behalf so that they can have confidence in the product.



What does Accreditation mean?

Accreditation, quite simply expresses the ATFA's confidence in a manufacturer to consistently produce quality solid or engineered flooring that meets the specific manufacturing requirements outlined above.

How do manufacturers gain accreditation?

To achieve accreditation manufacturers must have the necessary controls and recording systems operating that documents product compliance to specification. The manufacturing history of the flooring sold must also be traceable back to their drying and machining records. ATFA audits each site a number of times each year to ensure that standards are maintained at the required high level.

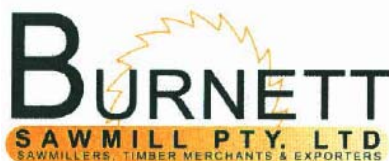
