About the Advanced Coatings Workshop

Who is this 1 day workshop for?

The aesthetic appearance of the coated surface of a timber floor is perhaps the most important aspect that provides for customer acceptance or rejection.

The workshop will cover an understanding of the types of coatings and the advantages and disadvantages of all variants. Specifically it will consider the 18 most common visual concerns and go into detail as to cause, avoidance, and rectification (see Workshop Outline specifics below).

This totally new workshop will use the new draft *ATFA Flooring Appearance Assessment Guide* as a reference and introduce what the ATFA Peer Review Committee has considered as acceptable and unacceptable in the rating of surface condition concern floors. As such this will add significantly to the knowledge of individuals who have participated in previous *Advanced Coatings Workshops* and more align our industry standards with client expectation.

This workshop is ideally suited to sanders and finishers, training instructors, flooring inspectors, insurance assessors, manufacturer technical and sales personnel, key contractors, wholesalers, suppliers, industry technical committee personnel and any others involved in the understanding and investigation of why coatings may behave in a certain manner.

Workshop Outline

More specifically this new workshop will cover:

1. Why are coatings used?
2. The history of timber floor coatings.
3. Types of coatings used today
4. The 18 main causes of customer concern (quilting, cobwebbing, tram lining, rejection, delamination, application marks, pitting, gloss variation, patchy stain application, grain raise, cold weather crystallisation, dust in coat, edge bonding, orange peel, uneven sanding, ghosting, filler colour mismatch, contact staining) will be reviewed in detail as to cause, avoidance, and rectification.
5. What is acceptable and what is not! ATFA peer reviewed assessment criteria will be presented for the very first time.

Please note any questions received via prior email on coated surfaces or coatings specifically will receive a comprehensive written response.
