- Certificate III in Flooring Technology

How to get there and get qualified

1. Via an apprenticeship for those wanting to join the industry.
2. Using Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for those already in the industry and who have some existing skills and knowledge.

The Certificate III in Flooring Technology is the qualification which underpins both pathways.

1. The Flooring Technology

Apprenticeship – sets you up with a trade future and a nationally recognised qualification. It introduces you to the world of work and sets your career in motion, with the potential to start your own business down the track.

The Certificate III in Flooring Technology is the nationally recognised trade qualification for the industry and provides you with the practical skills and knowledge you'll need to perform effectively in the timber flooring industry.

You will get skills and knowledge to:

- prepare sub-floors
- install timber floors
- sand and finish timber flooring
- repair existing flooring

You will also learn about occupational health and safety, communications, calculations and how to work effectively with others.

2. Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

– getting you there faster.

If you already have existing knowledge and experience relevant to the timber flooring industry, regardless of where or how it was acquired, you may get credit for this. RPL is a application process assisting you to provide documentary evidence of your skills and knowledge.

You may be eligible for RPL if you have:

- skills and knowledge already gained through the industry
- paid or unpaid work experience in the industry
- life experience
- community work experience

Apprentices must first be employed and registered as an apprentice.
